Being responsible for an AMOS system and being its administrator has many facets. A wide variety of programs help to administer the system, manage users and solve system problems. If these are also your tasks and/or you are or will be a system administrator for AMOS, then this training is just right for you.

- ✓ Configure the AMOS server
- ✓ Manage release changes
- ✓ Set parameters and create basic data essential for the use of AMOS
- ✓ Schedule tasks to performed at a given time and interval using AMOS Scheduler
- ✓ Monitor various elements of AMOS using the AMOS Control Centre
- ✓ Manage Maintenance Keys in AMOS
- ✓ Define and manage the required Units of Measurement in AMOS for various programs
- ✓ Customise various programs using Form Configuration
- ✓ Create Workorder ranges
- ✓ Understand the use of and manage Workflows within AMOS
- ✓ Create user roles and administer user access rights accordingly
- ✓ Perform data verification “post migration” and schedule data clean up tasks
- ✓ Manage users that are currently logged into AMOS and check on their login history
- ✓ View log files and the history of select entries in AMOS using the history viewer
- ✓ Analyse release changes and gain an overview warnings and errors
- ✓ Access the database to manage individual tables, execute SQL statements and manage select entries such as A/C registrations using Code Transfer
- ✓ Create KPI reports in a dedicated program for Engineering, Material Management, etc.
- ✓ Create support cases and manage current issues
- ✓ Manage the use of barcoding in AMOS
- ✓ Configure default settings in AMOS such as printers and automatic locking of the AMOS application
- ✓ Understand how electronic signature can be utilised in AMOS
- ✓ Set up and use the Storage Engine Manager
- ✓ Set up the Web-Drive within AMOS and define directories and access rights

- ✓ Manage OEM Documents
- ✓ Research the changes that have been implemented between AMOS versions due to extension, modifications, etc.
