This resulted in the launch of the AMOSmobile module "EXEC" (which stands for execution) in November 2015 at the AMOS Customer Conference in Lucerne, Switzerland.

Convinced that a close cooperation with members of the AMOS community can only be beneficial for the application, we decided to offer the AMOSmobile/EXEC module at an incentive price to a limited number of customers who are ready to extensively test this mobile solution and help Swiss-AS to complete and fine-tune the first AMOSmobile module.
