EASYJET SIGNS AGREEMENT WITH SWISS AVIATION SOFTWARE

Swiss AviationSoftware, Europe's industry-leading aviation maintenance management system provider officially announces a client relationship with easyJet, Europe's leading low-fares airline. This relationship will see Swiss-AS providing the fully-integrated AMOS application and associated implementation expertise as easyJet's new aircraft maintenance management system.

Following easyJet's decision to develop more in-house maintenance capabilities, easyJet launched a formal MRO Software evaluation process in order to select its own aircraft maintenance and engineering system. The goal is to gain more flexibility and independence from easyJet's MRO providers, and for their Technical Division, to assume responsibility for both Part-M and Part-145.

AMOS IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT ONGOING

Since project start the Swiss-AS project team have been assisting easyJet in matching existing processes with AMOS processes. This is aimed at adopting what has shaped up as "best practice" during more than 60 preceding successful AMOS implementations. The easyJet project team is now pressing ahead to complete the data transfer and has recently started with the training of the end-users.

With easyJet's goal to manage a single-type fleet of all A319 aircraft in AMOS the Go-Live is intended to be a phased approach and only relates to this specific aircraft type during Phase 1. The Go-Live - which is scheduled for June 2009 - includes the full range of AMOS modules and will allow easyJet to make use of the advanced functionality for which AMOS is highly regarded by its loyal customer base.
